**RENDEZVOUS RULES** will take effect on Friday September 23<sup>rd</sup> at 7:00 a.m. Please help us keep this event primitive. Attendance at a primitive event means: All clothing, lodges and accouterments must be in the period of 1640 to 1840 in North America. Absolutely no modern footwear and sunglasses of any kind, unless medically required. Period eye wear is encouraged for those wearing glasses. Eye and hearing protection is encouraged on the firing line only! All modern items (coolers, bottles, cans, plastic, etc.) must be kept out of sight at all times. No propane, kerosene heaters, coleman lanterns, charcoal lighter fluid will be permitted. Food vendors are one of two exceptions. Special consideration will be made, if necessary, to handicapped campers with regards to the possession and use of flammable liquids. Please contact a staff member for details. Modern weapons will not be permitted in camp.

**CAMERAS AND CELL PHONES** All photography equipment must be covered when not in use and **NO FLASH** photography. **Turn cell phones off or on vibrate while in camp.** Talking or texting in areas other than behind closed doors is **STRICTLY PROHIBITED! CELL PHONE RESTRICTIONS WILL BE ENFORCED!** Handicap participants must abide by the rules as much as possible, please. Handicap carts, walkers and **registered Service animals are allowed.**

**EARLY SET UP AND GATE HOURS:** Early setup will begin Wednesday September 21<sup>st</sup>. There is no early set up fee if pre-registered. If you are not pre-registered; the fee is \$5.00 per day, per person, for early set up. Camp is open for general setup on Friday September 23<sup>rd</sup>, gate time for set up is 7:30am to 6:00pm. Once camp is open there will be a 1 hour time limit for unloading and loading vehicles. All vehicles must be out of camp 1 hour before gates close. **Opening Ceremony is 7pm Friday 9/23. You MUST be in period clothes** once your canvas is up and at all times in primitive camp from 9pm Friday 9/23 until **closing ceremonies Saturday 10/1 at 12 noon.**

**PUBLIC DAYS** are **Sat Sept 24<sup>th</sup> and Sun Sept 25<sup>th</sup> from 10am to 5pm** the entire camp is open to visitors. **Mon Sept 26<sup>th</sup> through Fri Sept 30<sup>th</sup> from 10am to 5pm, open to the Merchants Area ONLY.** Admission for Visitors is Adults \$5.00, Seniors over 65 \$2.00, Children under 16 and persons with Military ID, free. **NO PETS ALLOWED AT ANY TIME – THIS INCLUDES CAMPERS AND VISITORS**  
**CAMPING AREA(S)** Handicapped Camping Area is provided and is close to the Handicapped parking area. Special consideration will be made, if necessary to handicapped campers with regards to the possession and use of flammable liquids. NO propane, kerosene heaters, Coleman lanterns and charcoal lighter fluid will be permitted. Food Venders are one of two exceptions. There will be no camping permitted in the parking lot.



There will be a modern camping area with no hookups. Firewood, water and dumpsters will be provided. All trash must be in tied plastic bags. Ice and trash bags must be covered when taken to and from your camp. Ice will be available daily. Water will be located in stations SEPARATE from the hooters. Please note: **DO NOT RINSE YOUR CHAMBER POTS/CAMP POTTIES AT THE WATER STATIONS!!!!!!!!!!!!!! THIS POSES A SERIOUS SANATATION RISK. ANYONE FOUND DOING SO, WILL BE TOLD TO PACK UP AND LEAVE.** Do not litter at any time. Please leave your area the same way you found it. Policing of refuse, especially cigarette butts, is up to you and your neighbor. Please preserve our unsoiled reputation by cleaning your camp site.

**FIRES** must be contained in a pit and must be attended at all times. A minimum of two gallons of water in an open container must be kept within five feet of the fire pit specifically for fire control. NO cutting of live trees or brush. Please fill and level your fire pit when you leave. DO NOT bury partially burned wood or trash. Return unused wood to the nearest station.

**PROPANE** will be permitted to food vendors only and the containers must be kept out of sight at all times. Commercial food vendor's equipment will be inspected by the Rendezvous staff for safety. Fire extinguishers are required by state law! Inspectors have the final word concerning the safety of your set up.

**NO ANIMALS** other than horses and mules will be allowed in camp. All horses and mules are required to have a current Coggins test (within one year) and all horses and mules from outside Virginia need a current health certificate. These will be checked by the horse captain. A designated horse camp will be provided. You are responsible for the safety, conduct and feed of your animals. All wagons, buggies and accessories must be period appropriate. **NO PETS are allowed on the property.**

**TRADE POLICY** A Sutler is defined as anyone offering a total of \$1500.00 or more in non-personal items for sale or trade. A Blanket Trader is anyone offering a total of \$750.00 or less in personal items for sale or trade that will fit on a four point (72"x90") blanket. The only items to be displayed sold or traded in any way are original or reproductions of articles in common use in North America during the period of 1640 to 1840. NO modern packaging, labels or price tags to be displayed. Books, patterns, paintings, etc., must deal directly with or depict the 1640 to 1840 period and must be displayed in a trade shelter. For all trade related matters, the decision of the Trade Committee is final. Blanket traders are also required to abide by all trade rules. A trade license will be issued upon inspection by Trade Committee. This license must be displayed at all times.

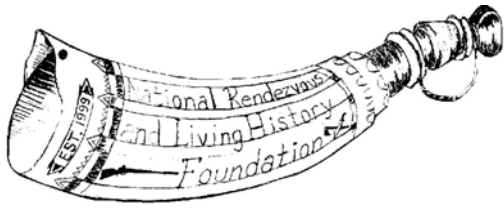
**NOTICE TO ALL** – including dealers and possessors of FURS, CLAWS, FEATHERS, ETC. It is YOUR responsibility to confirm the compliance of your goods with the Virginia game regulations as well as Federal Laws. **THIEVERY** (NO THIEVES!) and fighting of any kind will not be tolerated. Violators will be turned over to the police. Thieves will be ejected from camp IMMEDIATELY. The sale, trade or barter of alcohol is prohibited by the Commonwealth of Virginia.

**ARTILLERY** will be permitted on the designated range during posted times and only upon a safety inspection by the Artillery Range Officer.

**PRE-REGISTRATION DEADLINE IS AUG. 23, 2011! PLEASE PRE-REGISTER**

Rendezvous fees include medallion, all events, seminars (make and take seminars may have a small cost), competitions and Camp Feast. Pre-Registration is \$45.00 per person for NMLRA members and dependants are \$22.50. Participants who are not NMLRA members, their spouse or significant other, pre-registration is \$55.00 per adult per Rendezvous. All children under 18 free. **\*All registrations at the gate will be charged additional \$10.00 per person.** Trader fees are \$35.00 (does NOT include registration fee). Blanket Trader fee is \$10.00 for traders with goods for sale between \$500.00 and \$1500.00 (does NOT include registration fee). Please check trade policy for value amount of your trade goods allowed for all blanket traders. Make checks payable to NRLHF, P.O. Box 376, Hershey, PA 17033. ## General Registration instructions And Definitions

**Payment:** Make checks/ money orders payable to **NRLHF** (US funds only) and mail to the address listed above.

The NRLHF provides a preferred rate for NMLRA members and their immediate families. Immediate family includes spouse and legal dependants. Any person expelled or denied membership in the NMLRA is excluded from the preferred rate for their selves and their family members. **Participants attending a NRLHF event must show a current NMLRA membership card of a member of that family in order to obtain the reduced rate.**

Participants who are not NMLRA members may attend foundation events and participate in all activities and competitions fully and on an even basis with NMLRA members. However they must pay the full fee.

Dependant does NOT include a registrants spouse or partner regardless of age. The term dependant as used by the NRLHF includes those individuals who can be claimed by the registrant as a dependant for Federal Income Tax purposes.

There is no early set up fee for participants who are pre-registered

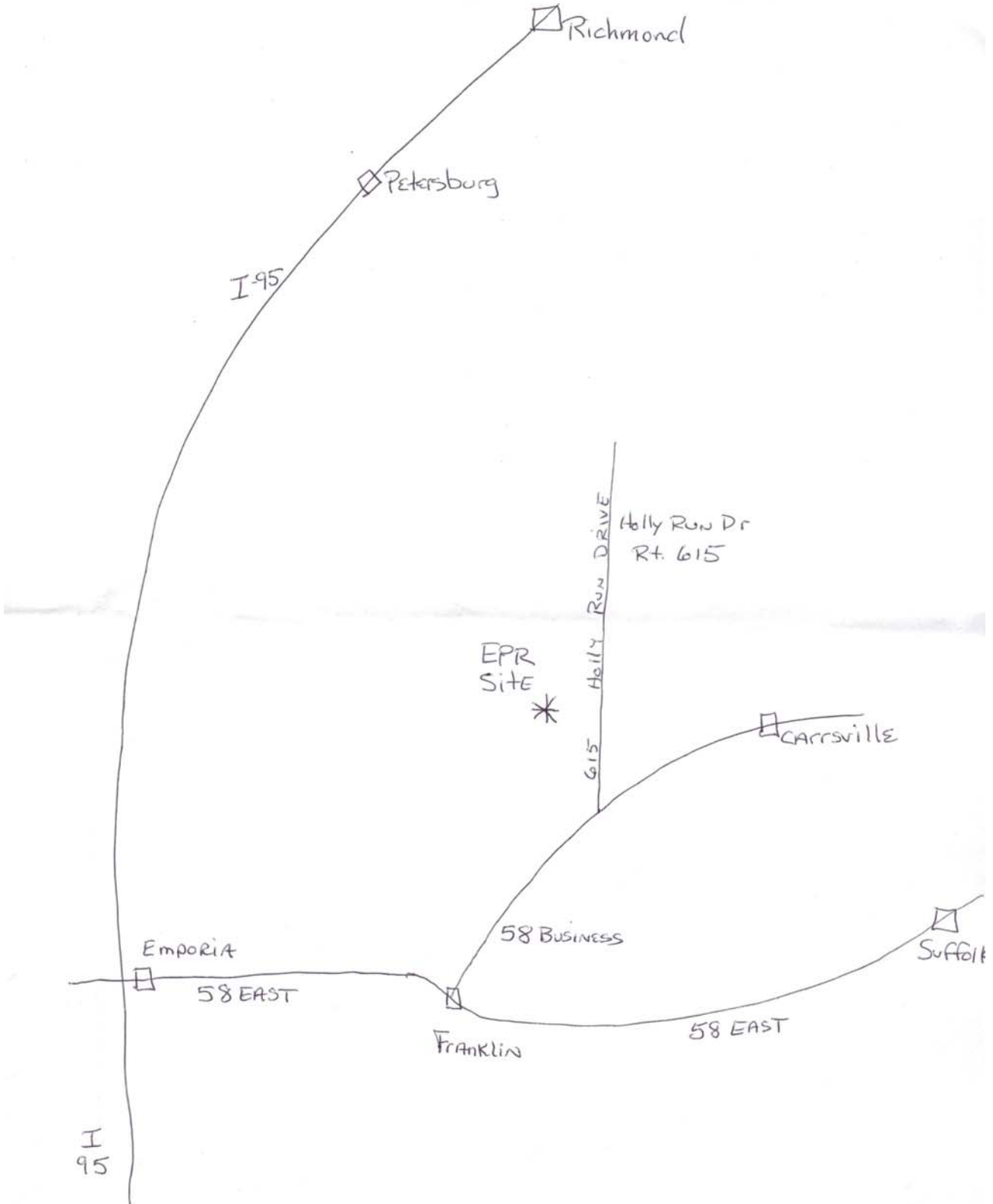
NO ONE, not on the Booshways staff will be permitted to set up prior to the Wednesday preceding the start of the event, with the exception of the Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer.

**NO PETS ARE ALLOWED ON THE PROPERTY AT ANY TIME, THIS INCLUDES CAMPERS AND VISITORS, WITH THE EXCEPTIONS OF SERVICE ANIMALS.**

Each participant who registers for a NRLHF rendezvous as a trader must also pay participant fee, along with the applicable trade fee. Traders must comply with all NRLHF trade rules.

In the event that someone does not attend the Foundation event for which he/she was pre-registered, he/she can request **in writing** a refund of the pre-registration fees **within 30 days of the close of the event**. Refund requests are to be submitted to the Business Office.

Additional rules may apply as stated in the rendezvous Gate Book. You are responsible for reading your gate book.
